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# Internships | Home-Based Therapeutic Services

Interns will learn to work with an experienced clinical team, and interact with children of various ages and ranges of disabilities.

### Responsibilities

- Work alongside master level clinicians (BCBA, LICSW, LMHC) to gain clinical insight and further career development
- Work 1:1 with a child in their home or community setting
- Run interventions for behavior concerns and programs that teach skills
- Implement treatment plans, collect and track data and evaluate progress of clinical goals
- Give ongoing feedback to clinical team members about progress, questions, concerns

### **Job Requirements**

- Be 19 years of age or older
- Be currently enrolled in degree program, preferably pursuing a degree in health sciences, human services, psychology, human resource management, but not limited to these degree programs.
- Demonstrate computer proficiency for data entry, e-mail, Internet, Microsoft Office 2010-2019 (Word, PowerPoint and Excel).
- Have a favorable background check, driving record and fingerprint results
- Undergo Department of Children Youth and Family Services (DCYF) clearance
- Have valid driver's license and access to an insured vehicle
- Demonstrate competency to work with children/adolescents with disabilities and special healthcare needs
